

## **Parent Involvement:**

### **Title I:**

The goal of the Title I program is to ensure that all children have an equal opportunity to obtain a high-quality education and reach proficiency on state academic achievement assessments.

Alba-Golden ISD qualifies as a Title I schoolwide program because at least 40% of the students are considered economically disadvantaged.

The main component of the Title I program is a strong parent/school relationship. Each campus works with families to support success by offering various parental involvement opportunities throughout the school year. Before you volunteer, you must complete a criminal background check. This helps to keep students safe at our school. A release form can be picked up at either campus office.

One shared goal is to focus on communication. To support the partnership between school and home, please keep your child's teacher informed about family changes that may affect your child and read information that is sent home. If questions come up throughout the school year, please contact your child's teacher or school administrator.

### **Migrant Program:**

Alba-Golden ISD helps the state of Texas identify students who may qualify for Migrant Program Services, which provide extra help to students of migrant families. If your family has moved any time during the last three years from one school district to another, your child might be eligible for services. The reason for the move must be related to finding temporary or seasonal work in agriculture, job packing, processing, harvesting or cultivating crops, food processing, dairy work,
