

## Dual Credit Courses Offered at Alba-Golden High School Through Tyler Junior College

10th and 11th grade students wanting to take college courses their Junior or Senior year will need to take TSI. TSI is the Tyler Junior College entrance exam. It consists of a reading, writing, and mathematics section. Next year's juniors will need to pass the **Reading and Writing** sections of TSI and attempt the math section to take a college class. Next year's seniors only need to pass the section that applies to the course they are taking, for example to take English 1301 they would need to pass reading and writing. Students may be exempt from TSI if they meet one of the following:

- PSAT: combined score of 107 and at least a 50 on the critical reading and mathematics (2015-2016 PSAT score standards haven't been approved by TJC)
- ACT: composite score of 23 and a minimum of 19 on math and English
- SAT: combined verbal and math of 1070 and a minimum of 500 on the verbal and math test
- A score of 4000 or higher on the Algebra I EOC and passing grade in the Algebra II course
- A score of 4000 or higher on the English II EOC

### Spring

ENGL 1302—dual credit for English IV (.5 cr.) T/Th 8:00-9:15

HIST 1302—college credit only M/W 8:00-9:15

MATH 1342-Introduction to Statistics—dual credit for math (.5 cr.) M-F:

MATH 2413-Calculus I-dual credit for math (.5 cr.)

BIOL 1407-dual credit for science (1.0 cr.) M-F:

BIOL 2404- Intro to A&P- dual credit for science (.5cr)

SPCH 1315 online (Mrs. Boeckman is the teacher)

ARTS 1301 online (elective dual credit .5)

PSYC 2301 online (elective dual credit .5)

- Each of these classes is a 3/4-hour college credit course, which will be on your TJC transcript. TJC courses will transfer to most colleges and universities.
- The dual credit grades will also be on your high school transcript. These are weighted courses (**for GPA purposes only**). **The grade you receive from TJC is the grade that will be posted to your transcript.**

***Tyler Junior College Dual Credit Office will register students on our campus at the end of each semester. Students will be responsible for payment of classes. However, students that are on the free and reduced lunch program will not be required to pay for their courses. Tyler Junior College will pay for ½ tuition and Alba-Golden will pay the other ½. Students are only allowed to take three courses per semester, if they choose to take more, payment will need to be made by the student. Tyler Junior College only allows dual credit students to take up to 15 hours per semester.***

***Students that are not on free and reduced lunch program will be reimbursed one course per semester by the school district. Students will be required to make the initial payment to remain enrolled in the course before a check is issued from the school. Once reimbursement checks are issued, it is the student's responsibility to make sure their account at TJC is paid. They can pay online, by mail, or phone. Reimbursement checks will not be issued until the last day to drop in each semester. This is usually close to the end of the semester. All students are responsible for purchasing books before the first class day. Used books may be purchased at a cheaper cost from students that have previously taken the course at school or the campus bookstores.***
